The aim of the research



- to determine the morbidity of the population in the two Municipalities of the project (Arriana and Iasmos),
- to investigate its correlation with the socio-economic elements of the inhabitants and
- to assess their accessibility to health structures

in order to support the formulation of appropriate prevention health policies in the two areas concerned.



The research methodology (1/3)



prepared by PB2 - the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki - Department of Economics

The questionnaire consists of three parts:

- The first, **general part**, includes 12 questions (Q1-Q12) that collect information on demographic and socio-economic characteristics of the participants
- The **second part on perceived morbidity** includes six questions (Q13-Q18). The interviewer has to code the perceived morbidity problem(s) (until 10 problems) mentioned with the help of the International Classification of Primary Care-version 2 (ICPC-2).
- In the third part, issues of access to health services and degree of needs' coverage are investigated.



The research methodology (2/3)



- For each of the mentioned health problems, the participants are asked (four questions (Q19-Q22) whether they believe that their problem(s) has been solved/ treated/ controlled in a scale from 0 to 10.
- Additional questions (Q23-Q26) follow about the use of preventative services, the number of times they had used any health service last year, or they have been admitted to a hospital and the amount of money they have spent on own expenses for the various health services.
- Finally, participants are asked to specify if they had confronted any obstacles/problems or even barriers in accessing health care services during the last year (Q27), in an effort to investigate the special challenges that this population is facing.



The research methodology (3/3)



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- the research is addressed to 1000 persons in each area
- an electronic questionnaire has been developed
- the questionnaire has been coded
- the interviewers have been trained
- the research is in progress since December 2018
- the survey is expected to be completed by mid-March 2019
